

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-7

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL TO
CHANGE CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021,
REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE
HILL, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2020-17, passed December 14, 2020, be amended to change appropriation for 2021 in the NOPEC Fund line item to the following amount:
